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Zero Conditional Tense English Grammar Rules

The zero (0) conditional is the **factual conditional**. It is used to talk about habits, scientific facts, general truths, instructions and rules, *if something else happens first*.

- These are things that are **real**, so this conditional is also called the **real factual conditional** or the **real present conditional**.
- When we are thinking about **facts** which are generally **true**, we use:

If + Present Simple, Present Simple

- If you put water in the freezer, it becomes ice.
- If you stand in the rain, you get wet.
- If you heat ice, it melts.
- You can see in the examples about the condition always has the same result.
- Notice how we use a comma after the first present simple tense clause.

CONDITIONALS

ZERO CONDITION
 If + Condition + Result

IF + Simple Present Tense + Simple Present Tense

USE

- General Truths
- Habits
- Real World
- Scientific Facts, etc.

EXAMPLES:

- If it rains, the ground gets wet.
- If I cry, I have a headache.
- If you mix yellow and blue, you get green.
- If you are tired, you go to bed early.
- If you leave the object, it drops
- If you pour oil on water, it floats.
- If you smoke, you get old early.
- If you leave the object, it drops.

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ZERO CONDITIONAL
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Use the (zero conditional) to talk about what happens in general, every time, when a condition exists.

If clause (condition) + **comma** + **main clause (result)**

If a condition **exists** , the result **is** true.

present (simple, continuous or perfect) present (simple, continuous or perfect)

→ If the food **is** out of date, I **don't** eat it.

→ If I **have drunk**, I **don't** drive.

→ If you **are talking**, I **can't** concentrate

→ I **can't** concentrate if you **are talking**.

→ **When** you are talking, I can't concentrate.

We can normally replace IF with WHEN without changing the meaning

NO COMMA when you put the main clause at the beginning

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We can also reverse the order and use:

Present Simple + If + Present Simple

- You get wet if you stand in the rain.
- Ice melts if you heat it.
- I can't sleep if I drink coffee at night.
- Plants die if you don't water them.
- Notice how the comma is not necessary with this word order.

We can put the main clause at the beginning. Then we don't use a comma between the two clauses.

- I never **go** to bed late **if** I **have** to get up early.

We can usually replace the **if** in this conditional with **when** without changing the meaning.

- Dogs can attack you **when** you are scared.
- **When** the weather is bad, people don't go shopping.

1. Habits:

In English, use the present simple tense to talk about habits and daily routines:

I walk the dog every day.

I call my mother once a week.

I babysit my grandchildren every week.

- You can also use the zero conditional sentence structure to talk about your habits, or things that you always do in certain situations or conditions.

Finish these sentences with what you do in these situations:

If I get sick, I ...

If I miss the train, I ...

If I don't sleep well, I ...

If I drink, I ...

If it's hot, I ...

If it snows, I ...

Remember: You are thinking about your habits, not a specific situation that is happening today or that will possibly happen tomorrow.

- Now, take a look at these sentences. Do you do these things? When do you do these things?

I stay home from work.

I drive to work.

I am cranky in the morning.

I never drive.

I go to the beach.

I shovel the driveway.

- These things are connected. Let's put them together in the zero conditional sentence structure.

If I get sick, I stay home from work.

If I miss the train, I drive to work.

If I don't sleep well, I am cranky in the morning.

If I drink, I never drive.

If it's hot, I go to the beach.

If it snows, I shovel the driveway.

- **Zero conditional:**

*What do you like to do **on weekends**?*

If it's hot, I usually go to the beach.

If it's cold, I stay home and watch Netflix.

(I am talking about my general habits.)

2. General truths & facts:

These things are not scientific facts, but they are things that are true, or that we generally believe are true.

If the banana is yellow, it is ready to eat!
 It's bad luck if the groom sees the bride before the wedding!
 If the police catch you driving too fast, you get a speeding ticket.
 If you make more money, you pay more income tax.

3. Instructions & Rules:

You can use the **imperative** in the result-clause to give instructions, advice, or explain rules.

If you want to lose weight, **eat** less and **exercise** more.
 If you drink, **don't drive**.
 Please **don't disturb** me if I am asleep!
Eat something if you're hungry.
Call me if you feel sad.
 If you don't like your job, **quit!**
 If you want to speak to someone, **press** 1.
